Whereas, the City of Mabton Police Department no longer has a need for certain property used in the conduct of City business or said property has outlived its useful life, and,


Whereas, the City Council has determined that said property is no longer needed.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Mabton, as follows:

- one 19 inch computer monitor Dell (used)
- nine, Toughbook Laptop computers (discontinued/obsolete/used)
- one, RCA Super 8 video camcorder recorder with case (used, obsolete)
- one, Magnavox DVD TV, 19 inch (used/obsolete)
- one, Compaq Computer screen 17inch (used, missing parts)
- one Hitachi VHS TV 10 inch (used, obsolete)
- two, discontinued Window tint readers (non-usable)
- two, GE Digital Cameras (obsolete, non-working)
- box of misc. used batteries for old radios
- one, Sony HandCam with case (old, obsolete)
- box of old discontinued portable radios with parts and chargers (obsolete)
- box of misc. radio parts and items (discontinued)
- one, Compaq computer key board (used)
- one, Compaq computer tower (old, obsolete, outdated)
- one, HP printer (outdated/obsolete)
- box of two used fax machines
- one, used discontinued projector

The above listed items will be surplus and of no value and will be scrapped upon approval or will be sold with the result of any proceeds from the sale of surplus items being deposited in the General Fund.


