A. Yakima County Sheriff's Department Contract

There was discussion of the actual fiscal impact of a switch from a regular PD to a contract with the sheriff's office. There are many benefits to making this change financially as well as far liability with compliance and training etc. They decided to move to hear a formal contract at the regular meeting.

B. Mayor's salary increase.

The mayor has been working many hours at the Waste Water Facility after the Waste Water Operator's resignation. Jamin: Well #6 is progressing; they put in the liner last week. The Reservoir is painted. Well #4 has a generator and can run 24/7 if need be. Met with Pacific Power to discuss the power issue at Well #4; they have not yet found a solution to the issue but they are working to put in VFD.

Arturo: Stated that the drinking fountain on the corner of B and Main still is not working. Jamin said that he would look into it.
