City Engineer Jamin said they are still working on the crack monitors for the building and that they have mailed out the income surveys.

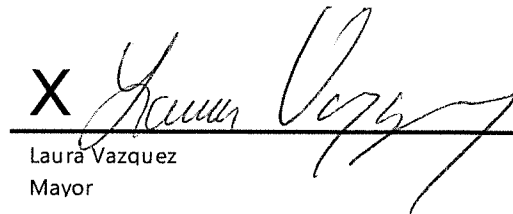
7. Mayor's Report
