Tuesday March 27, 2018

2. New Business

A. New Developments in the Potential Annexation of the Gannon Property

City Attorney James Carmody advised that the Gannon's were going to ask again for the city's support for their Emergency annexation. He explained that they have went to the county to further explain the situation and the county has agreed to this process and said they would be supportive should the city decide to agree. He said that we are not making any decision tonight except for to set a date to have a public hearing on the matter. He said that the desire for this project was being generated from 2 primary sources; the Gannon's and Farmworker's clinic. He said that any and all costs to prepare and submit this information will bear all cost starting with a \$5000 deposit subject to change. Mr. Carmody's office has already created a separate place to charge the Gannon's for their services. There are several more things involved with this issue but ultimately the city agreed to add a motion to set a date for public hearing to the regular council meeting.

B. Golden Gate Line Extension

Golden Gate is to bear all cost of putting the line in. Their plans for this are subject to the city engineer (Gray & Osborne) approval.

C. Cemetery Discussion

There is no policy in place about how far loved ones should be from the casket at the time of internment. There was an issue that happened in a neighboring town and a state wide suggestion that there be a policy in place for safety reasons. In other cities that distance is 50' away from the graveside. This is what was suggested.


Arturo said that he worked for the city for a very long time and never had an issue with this but that it would be up to the individual.
