Tuesday February 25, 2020

2. New Business

A. Contract with Cintas

The original plan was for shirts only for the Public Works Employees. It was explained that upon talking through the details Cintas has a minimum requirement of \$35 a week. This equates to \$1800 a year at a minimum. This is more than the clothing allowance is allotted. Arturo explained that during his time in Public Works he had issues with taking his work clothing home and that his family developed a rash from the residual left behind; even though he was washing his clothes separately. His feeling was that it was a safety issue not to have uniforms cleaned by an outside party. Other council members agreed that having PW easily identifiable and professional in appearance outweighed the extra money. City Treasurer Jamison is going to get some better numbers to make a more informed decision on what they would like to have.

The Lieutenant talked briefly about the 7-year-old that went missing. He said that he posted this to Facebook and the boy was found in less that half an hour. This post was shared over 7000 times.

There was some discussion about the details of the Humane Society contract. Council was unhappy with the rate that they are being charged. They are also going to look into what other options there are for managing the animal problem. They also going to talk about the options for a permanent contract. We are currently paying by the animal picked up.
