A. Discussion of Ordinance 854 Establishing Council Meeting Attendance Requirements for Council Members


There was some discussion about how many excused absences a council member could currently have. Everyone was comfortable with "three consecutive unexcused" but there was some discussion about how many a person should be allowed "excused" before it becomes an issue. City Attorney James Carmody to review and bring some information back for the next meeting.

B. Discussion of "Dump Day" With a Fee for Residents Wishing to Participate. Vera explained that when this issue came up previous she did an impromptu survey and no one that she talked to about it was opposed to the idea of paying a small fee per load; it still saves residents money and time from trying to get to the dump themselves. They discussed how much the fee would be. It was decided that there would be a charge of \$5 per load. There needs to be a discussion with city staff on exactly how this process will be feasible. This also needs to be run through the mayor and will be brought to the next council meeting.
