

Fireworks Permit

Ordinance No. 2015-1055**Passed on July 28, 2015 by the City of Mabton,**

Section 6. Discharge of Consumer Fireworks. Consumer fireworks may only be discharged by licensed persons holding a city permit; a permit shall cost \$25.00 and shall identify the location of the discharge site and the responsible individuals, with their contact information. Permit shall be subject to rules and regulations as may be adopted from time-to-time by the Mayor after consultation with local fire official and as otherwise directed under consistent provisions of the State Fireworks Law.

- (a) Fireworks may be used, fired or discharged only on the 4th of July of each year and only on the 31st day of December of each year commencing at 8:00 pm and ending at 12:00 Midnight, except as follows:
- (i) It is unlawful to use, fire or discharge any fireworks along the route of and during any parade or at any place of public assembly or in any commercial use district;
 - (ii) It is unlawful at any time to throw or toss any fireworks at any person, animal, vehicle or other thing or object.

Section 13. Violation – Penalty. Failure to perform any act required by this chapter, or the performance of any act prohibited by this chapter, is designated as an infraction and may not be classified as a criminal offense. Any person found to have committed an infraction under this chapter shall be assessed a monetary penalty. No penalty may exceed \$500 for each separate infraction.
